Approach

We support institutional transformation focused on improving course outcomes for racially-minoritized and poverty-affected students using digital learning courseware and tools.

Outcomes

- **Discover** how high-quality digital learning can address institutional challenges related to course and degree completion, consider the range of courseware and tools available in the market today, and learn how these technologies can benefit both students and instructors.
- **Understand** the foundational components needed to teach effectively with courseware including equity-minded practice, tool integration and alignment, actionable learning analytics, and a comprehensive approach to support for students using courseware.
- Review the key considerations and resources available for digital learning technology selection and implementation including efficacy, equity, functionality, and student and instructor needs. Plan for the redesign of one or more courses using courseware.
- Implement high-quality digital learning technologies while placing the needs of Black, Latinx, Indigenous, poverty-affected, and first-generation college students at the center of the learning experience. Adopt continuous improvement approaches to support iteration on redesigned courses and scale courseware use across departments and programs.
